TRENTHAM IN JANUARY

Rainfall 72.1mm Av 54.5
Mean max temp. 23.4°C Av 21.9°C

Mean min temp 11.9°C, Av 9.8
HOT SPELLS THEN HUMID, THUNDERY.

Residual warmth after the record December heat on 31st was followed by a mild spell with strong SSE winds. Heat returned on 8th before a cool interlude with rain on 11th. Conditions became humid and thundery on 20th, with a hot spell followed by briefly cooler conditions and strong SSE winds. Very humid, thundery weather 26-28th saw brief downpours: 20mm fell in 45 minutes on 28th. Cooler, less humid weather followed. Both rainfall and temperatures were above average.
